- **Vision, Planning and Accountability**
 - To work with the leadership of STK to inspire vision for Youth ministry in line with the vision of the church
 - To think and plan strategically in order to achieve responsibilities
- **Safeguarding**
 - To provide pastoral care and oversight, working with the safeguarding officer ensure full compliance with safeguarding policy, and to ensure a safe environment for all young people and youth activities.
 - Ensuring the health and safety of the young people in all activities and events making sure that safety procedures are in place, known, understood and adhered to.
 - Ensuring safer recruitment and all appropriate clearances are obtained for those who have contact with young people.
